
SOUR DOUGH STARTER BLOCK



8 inch finished block - (can be made larger by adding more rows)

Cut 32 different fabrics - 1 ½ in. x 2 ½ in. for 8 inch block.

Follow the illustration by sewing 2 rectangles together along the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ in side. (piece 1 and 2)

Continue sewing block in the fashion of a "court house steps" block.

To make the square in a square block, cut 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. squares of contrasting fabric. Cut on the diagonal and sew to each side of the sour dough square. Trim larger square to 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches.

The block can be set in any way you desire.

****To make a larger block (about 12" square) use 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" pieces*****
